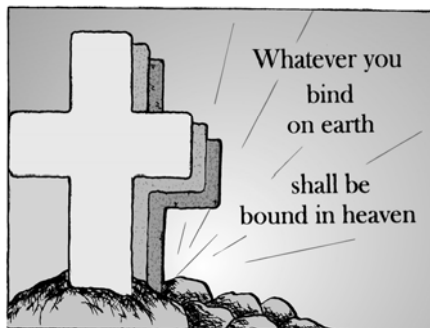

1. Season of Repairs! It goes without saying that there are only two seasons: Winter season and season of Repairs. Our parish courtyard or parking lot is going through massive repairs. It was reported to us by the Archdiocesan property inspectors that the parking lot needs immediate repair work. We were asked to submit three bids for approval by the Archdiocese. We never thought that the work will start immediately! Just last Friday, 15th August, 2008, we were informed that the work will start on Monday, 18th August 2008. The entire project will be supervised by the Archdiocese and Mr. Joe Augelli, our Parish Manager and Mr. Mike Cruz, Building and Ground Manager. I know it is in good hands!
2. Welcome Back Children! Sacred Heart School reopened on Thursday 21st August, 2008. We are all happy to see our children back to school. RUMOR HAS IT . . .

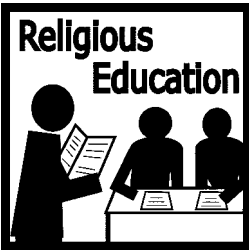
During Jesus' time, there were many beliefs circulating about the Messiah, the Christ, the Anointed of God. Matthew, Mark, and Luke all recount the story of Peter's profession of faith at Caesarea Philippi; only Matthew inserts the portion we hear today in which this inbreaking manifestation of faith for Peter makes of him the rock on which Jesus can found a church. Jesus knows, as he illustrated earlier in Matthew's Gospel with the parable of the houses built on sand and rock, that nothing can endure that doesn't have a sure foundation. We also hear Jesus today immediately follow up Peter's profession with a strict command not to go around right away and tell this to others. The faith that breaks in is the foundation, but it

takes time and teaching and discernment to comprehend it adequately in order to tell others about it. Indeed, in all three Gospels, the very first thing Jesus does after he is revealed as Christ through Peter's faith is to begin teaching his followers that to be "Messiah" or "Christ" means to suffer much and to die, neither of which was commonly believed about God's Anointed One.

ON EARTH AS IN HEAVEN

Throughout the Gospels there is a relentless teaching by Jesus that how we live and act on earth is intimately connected to the workings of God's heavenly reign. "Your will be done on earth as in heaven" we pray, along with "forgive us as we forgive others." In Matthew's Gospel the Last Judgment is portrayed with us being told that the manner in which we treated the hungry, poor, lowly, and oppressed is how we treated Christ. Today Jesus gives Peter—and all of us, the baptized, the church—our vocation. We can misread or misunderstand this passage to think that we have been imbued with some sort of control over the workings of heavenly grace and mercy. Rather, Jesus gives us a potent (and a bit overwhelming) charge to live the life of heaven's boundless forgiveness, to be witnesses to him, the Messiah, the Christ who, as he died on the cross to fulfill the work of those names, made his last words, "Father, forgive them."


