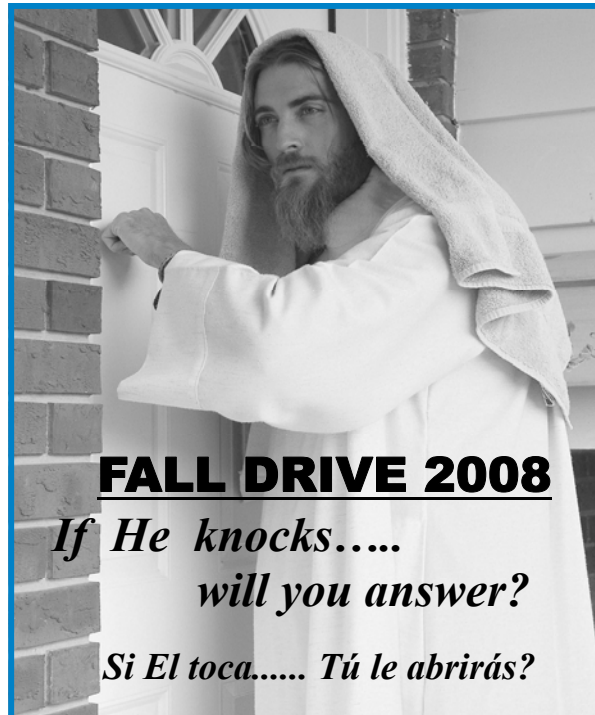
## MISSION STATEMENT

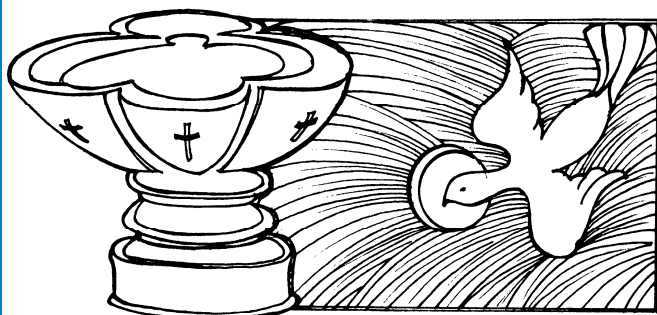

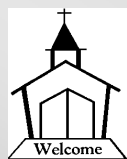

These are some items they would enjoy from home, sorted into 6 categories, that soldiers do not have readily available to them. **TOILETRIES:** Hand wipes, toothpaste and tooth brushes, mouth wash and breath strips, dental floss, shampoo (no-rinse and regular) skin lotion, sun block, chapstick, soap, shaving gel and deodorant (non-aerosol), disposable razors. **SPECIAL NEEDS:** "Rain-X" anti-fog (for goggles from any dept., or auto store), sunglasses (any type), letters of "support". **STATIONARY:** Birthday, anniversary and thank you cards (unsigned), paper, pencils, pens, envelopes. **FOOD:** Energy drinks (canned), Gatorade (or) "Propel" packets, Kool-aid, Louisiana sauce, candy (bars and hard), peanuts (any type), sunflower and pumpkin seeds, gum, tic-tacs, Twinkies, Ding-Dongs, etc., potato and/or Corn chips, canned sardines, tuna, anchovies, Spaghettios, chicken and/or Ramen noodle soups, snack crackers, "slim-jims" or beef jerky, protein bars, coffee, creamer (powdered), sugar, "Equal" or "Sweet N Low" packets. **CLOTHES:** White T-shirts, knee-cut socks **RECREATIONAL:** Nerf footballs, playing cards, batteries (AA or AAA most requested), DVD's & CD's (used or new), playstation, X-Box games (used or new), books, word puzzles, travel games

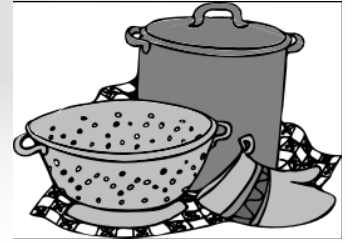

## REFLEXION DOMINGO XXXI: LOS FIELES DIFUNTOS

Por estos días, los católicos hemos recordado dos momentos importantes en nuestra vida de fe: (1) El 1º de Noviembre recordamos nuestra creencia en la "Comunión de los Santos", conformada por todos aquellos que en su muerte física, fueron considerados dignos de participar del gozo de la Vida Eterna. Así mismo hoy 2 de Noviembre, centramos nuestra memoria en todos los seres que han partido, en la espera de participar junto con ellos un día, del triunfal momento de la resurrección de los muertos. Hoy los invito a recordar algunas ideas básicas que la Iglesia nos enseña a propósito de estas dos fechas

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, al hablar de la Comunión de los Santos, dice: La Iglesia es "comunión de los santos": esta expresión designa primeramente las "cosas santas", y ante todo la Eucaristía, "que significa y al mismo tiempo realiza la unidad de los creyentes, que forman un solo cuerpo en Cristo".

Este término designa también la comunión entre las "personas santas" en Cristo que ha "muerto por todos", de modo que lo que cada uno hace o sufre en y por Cristo da fruto para todos.

"Creemos en la comunión de todos los fieles cristianos, es decir, de los que peregrinan en la tierra, de los que se purifican después de muertos y de los que gozan de la bienaventuranza celeste, y que todos se unen en una sola Iglesia; y creemos igualmente que en esa comunión está a nuestra disposición el amor misericordioso de Dios y de sus santos, que siempre ofrecen oídos atentos a nuestras oraciones".

Y en cuanto a la Resurrección de los muertos, agrega: "Creemos en Dios que es el creador de la carne; creemos en el Verbo hecho carne para rescatar la carne; creemos en la resurrección de la carne, perfección de la creación y de la redención de la carne. Por la muerte, el alma se separa del cuerpo, pero en la resurrección Dios devolverá la vida incorruptible a nuestro cuerpo transformado reuniéndolo con nuestra alma. Así como Cristo ha resucitado y vive para siempre, todos nosotros resucitaremos en el último día." "Creemos en la verdadera resurrección de esta carne que poseemos ahora"). No obstante, se siembra en el sepulcro un cuerpo corruptible, resucita un cuerpo incorruptible, un "cuerpo espiritual". Oremos por todos quienes han partido, para que gocen de la presencia de Dios y mañana también nosotros podamos gozar esa presencia.
