Building & Maintenance Collection This Weekend March 19th

Every month on the third weekend we will have our monthly second collection for our Building & Maintenance Fund. This will be used for the upkeep of our aging buildings that need many repairs, and also for special projects and improvements that we will announce. The collection is much needed to help offset our church's growing financial deficit and keep our parish financially strong. Upcoming capital repair projects include

the St. Eulalia Quinn/Church boiler water feed tank-cost is \$29,920.

We are looking for ways to reduce energy costs, and one way to effect large savings is to convert the lighting in St. Eulalia Church to LED lighting. We have solicited an energy consultant to take advantage of Com-Ed incentives and discounts for changing over to LED. The cost will be \$8,300. The cost can be reduced by replacing the current light fixtures with new ones, because the incentives are greater. The savings in energy costs will pay for the project in 1.6 years, and after that the energy/maintenance savings will be \$27, 642 and in \$55,283 in 10 years. We ask for your support in this project. Please mark your donation LED Lighting Project.

**LENTEN
OBLIGATIONS**

FAST & ABSTINENCE: Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Ash Wednesday and on all the Fridays of Lent. Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age and older, and younger than 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. The special Paschal fast, as well as abstinence, are prescribed for Good Friday and encouraged for Holy Saturday.

PRAYER: Please try to devote as much time to prayer & reflection as possible. Morning Mass is at 8:00am every weekday at Sacred Heart! Stations of the Cross are prayed every Friday of Lent at 6:00pm in English at Sacred Heart & 6:00pm in Spanish at St. Eulalia.

ALMSGIVING: Please try to help the poor during Lent. There are a number of ways: Operation Rice Bowl, Alms for the Poor, donating Clothes to St. Vincent DePaul and Catholic Charities via the white clothes donation bin in the parking lot, & donating time and food to the St. Eulalia Quinn Center Food Distribution on Tuesdays.

Como católicos bautizados e hijos de Dios, estamos llamados a cuidarnos unos a otros; no sólo en palabras, sino en hechos. Nuestra misión es construir el Reino de Dios en la tierra, y esta no es una misión fácil. Sin embargo, ¡es más fácil cuando todos hacen su parte y trabajan juntos! ¡Solo así podremos tener éxito!

Aquí hay algunas cosas para considerar por qué es tan importante ser un feligrés registrado:

- ◆ ¡Podemos adorar a Dios y estar agradecidos con Él como una gran familia participando en Misa todos los domingos y días festivos!
- ◆ Podemos aprender nuestra fe profundamente cuando traemos a nuestros hijos a la escuela católica o al programa de educación religiosa.

- ◆ También puede presentar el registro de sus apoyos y aportes para efectos fiscales de cada año, son deducibles de impuestos.

El uso de sobres es MUY importante para nuestra Iglesia para brindarle un mejor apoyo en caso de que lo necesite.

Desafortunadamente, si no tenemos registros en nuestro sistema, no podemos atenderlo como nos gustaría y como usted se merece. Al mismo tiempo, USTED necesita saber que TODA SU información personal es confidencial y NO se divulgará ni compartirá con terceros.


